This year has seen devastating effects due to COVID-19 pandemic in the country, all activities of life, institutions, businesses etc had a setback, the economy of the country is impacted seriously. Northern Regional Centre has not been spared and due to long shut down no activities could be conducted in NRC from April onwards.

However, Indian Institute of Chemical Engineers took an initiative to conduct Online Summer Internship Program (OISP-2002) during this period. This internship program was conducted in three batches and 9 subjects. Each subject matter was covered by one or more subject matter experts – a mix of academicians and industry experts. Total 1900+ students participated in this 4 week internship program. From NRC there were 3 subject matters expert and two presenters, who participated in this program.

The Foundation Day program was held on 15th February, 2020 in the Auditorium at IIChE (NRC). During this occasion two lectures were organized.

Dr. J.P. Gupta, Distinguished Scientist & Chairman, Environmental Impact Assessment, Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change, Government of India presented a paper on "Process Safety is one of the key driver to achieve Five Trillion Dollar Economy".

Dr. Soumitro Nagpal, Technical Director-Refining, Process Economics Program, IHS Markit presented a paper on "Refinery Configurations for Maximizing Crude Oil to Chemicals Conversion".

During the foundation day celebration, merit-cum-means scholarships were distributed to 20 students from AMU Aligarh, BCET Gurdaspur, DCRUST Murthal, IIT Delhi and IIT BHU.

CHEMCON - 2019

Indian Institute of Chemical Engineers (Northern Regional Centre), Chemical Engineering Department, IIT Delhi, Indian Oil Corporation Ltd (Industry Partner) and European Federation of Chemical Engineering (International Partner) jointly organised Indian Chemical Engineering Congress 'CHEMCON-2019' from 15th to 19th December, 2019 at IIT Delhi.

The Indian Chemical Engineering Congress coincided with Shri Dhirubhai Ambani Commemoration Lecture by Padma Vibhushan Prof. M. M. Sharma, FRS, Emeritus Professor of Eminence, ICT Mumbai.

The conference was Inaugurated on 15th December, 2019 by Shri Dharmendra Pradhan, Hon'ble Minister of Petroleum and Natural Gas and Ministry of Steel, Government of India in the presence of distinguished guests Director, IIT Delhi, Director (Refineries), Indian Oil Corp. Ltd., President, IIChE, Head, Petrochemical Academy, Reliance Industries Ltd. The highlight of Inaugural Session was Shri Dhirubhai Ambani Commemoration Lecture on "Innovation for Economic Growth with respect to Chemical Industries: Retrospect & Prospect" by Prof. M.M. Sharma. The Hon'ble Minister inaugurated the function by lighting of lamp and gave Inaugural Address.

The 'CHEMCON-2019' was sponsored by leading industries and institutions of India. There were 15 lectures on these topics delivered by subject experts and eminent speakers shared their knowledge and experiences during the event.

Parallel Sessions were held spread over two days wherein technical presentations by the authors were organised. There were more than 180 presentations during these sessions and was well attended.

Poster Sessions had presentations from 38 participants and it was well attended and keen involvement of delegates.

The CHEMCON-2019 was concluded by Valedictory Address by the President of IIChE and summarised the proceedings during the event. "The feedback by the participants and active participation by industry and institutions made this mega event a grand success and highly appreciated Congress during the recent past.
